

RESOLUTION NO. 10-105

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MADERA, CALIFORNIA, CALLING FOR AND GIVING NOTICE OF THE HOLDING OF A GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD IN THE CITY ON NOVEMBER 2, 2010, FOR THE PURPOSES OF VOTING ON THE ELECTION OF CERTAIN MUNICIPAL OFFICERS, AND ESTABLISHING ELECTORAL DISTRICTS FOR ELECTION OF MEMBERS OF THE CITY COUNCIL BY DISTRICTS AND ELECTION OF THE MAYOR OF MADERA AT LARGE AS REQUIRED BY THE PROVISIONS OF THE LAWS OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA RELATING TO GENERAL LAW CITIES, AND REQUESTING CONSOLIDATION THEREOF WITH THE STATEWIDE ELECTION TO BE HELD ON THE SAME DATE AND REQUESTING THE MADERA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS TO PERMIT THE MADERA COUNTY CLERK TO RENDER SPECIFIC SERVICES TO THE CITY OF MADERA RELATING TO THE CONDUCT OF THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION

WHEREAS, under the provision of the laws relating to general law cities in the State of California, a general municipal election shall be held on November 2, 2010, for the election of three City Council members; and

WHEREAS, under the provisions of California Government Code Sections 34870-34884 and 34900-34906, and the laws relating to general law cities in the State of California, a general municipal election shall be held on November 2, 2010 for the consideration of establishing electoral districts for election of members of the City Council by districts and election of the Mayor of Madera at large; and

WHEREAS, Section 10002 of the Elections Code of the State of California provides that the governing body of the City may by resolution request the Board of Supervisors of the County to permit the County Clerk to render special services to the City relating to the conduct of elections; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to call such election and request its consolidation with the statewide election to be held on the same date and have the County Clerk perform specified election services to the City of Madera.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MADERA, hereby resolves, determines, finds and orders as follows:

1. Pursuant to the Elections Code of the State of California there is called and ordered held in the City of Madera, California, on Tuesday, November 2, 2010, a general municipal election of the qualified electors of the City for the purpose of electing three members of the City Council for the full term of four years; and
2. Approval of a measure establishing electoral districts for election of members of the City Council by districts and election of the Mayor of Madera at large.
3. The ballots to be used at the election shall be in such form and content as may be required by law to be used at the election.
4. The proposition to be voted upon and the Statement of the Measure shall be answered with a yes or no and stated as follows:

DIVIDES THE CITY OF MADERA INTO SIX DISTRICTS FOR THE ELECTION OF CITY COUNCIL MEMBERS RESIDING IN THE DISTRICT THAT ELECTS THEM. PROVIDES FOR A MAYOR ELECTED ON A CITYWIDE BASIS.

“Shall members of the legislative body of the City of Madera be elected by districts described in Ordinance No. 871 C.S. and the Mayor of the City of Madera be elected on a citywide basis by the voters of the entire city?”

5. Pursuant to Section 10002 of the Elections Code, the City requests the Board of Supervisors of the County to permit the County Clerk to render special services to the City relating to this election.

6. The County Clerk is authorized and directed to do any and all things necessary in order to ensure the lawful conduct of any election which has been consolidated with City's elections in the County of Madera.
7. In all particulars not recited in this resolution, the elections shall be held and conducted as provided by law for holding elections in the City of Madera that are consolidated with any other elections.
8. Notice of the time and place of holding the elections is given and the County Clerk is authorized and directed to give such further or additional information in the time, form, and manner required by law in connection with consolidated elections.
9. Pursuant to Section 10403 of the Elections Code of the State of California, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Madera is hereby requested to consolidate the elections referred to herein with any election to be held on Tuesday, November 2, 2010.
10. For and in consideration of the election services to be rendered by the Madera County Clerk, the City of Madera agrees to pay to Madera County the City's proportionate share of the reasonable expenses of said election, said share to consist of all direct costs as determined by the Madera County Clerk related to the conduct of the City of Madera's general municipal election together with the City's proportionate share of the expenses for election services rendered by Madera County that are being shared equally with other jurisdictions, if any, by virtue of the consolidation of the City's municipal elections with elections

being held by other jurisdictions, if any, in the City of Madera on November 2, 2010.

11. The City Attorney is directed to prepare an Impartial Analysis concerning the Measure to be voted upon.


